# ARRIVAL

## GRADE 4 & 5

- Line up by class on back playground.
- Enter building single file.
- Walk down the first grade hall and go up the back stairway.

First floor staff members help keep order and make sure that students walk quietly on the right side of the hallway.

## KINDERGARTEN & GRADE 1

- First grade students line up by class in the main lobby hallway.
- Kindergarten and KinderPlus students line up by class in the MultiPurpose Room hallway.

After the 4th and 5th grade students go by, teachers/paras will lead their students from the lobby area to the classroom.

## GRADE 2 & 3

- Line up by class on back playground.
- Enter building single file.
- One second grade class will go directly to their first floor classroom.
- Other second and third grade students will go up side stairwell.

All second floor staff members, except teachers on bus duty, will be visible in hallway to make sure that students walk quietly on the right side of the hallway.

## MAIN STAIWAY

Only adults and students who arrive late and have tardy slips will use the main stairway in the lobby during school entry time.



# HALLWAY

Whenever walking in the hallways, students should walk:

- Quietly
- Single File
- On the right hand side of the hall

When walking up or down the stairways, students should:

- Keep to the right
- Use hand rails on stairs

Both classroom hallways and the Unified Arts hallway are designated as Quiet Zones. Please respect the posted signs.





# LUNCHROOM

Teachers will accompany students to the Lunchroom and make sure they are situated at their tables.

- Teachers will take time to demonstrate appropriate lunchroom behavior
- Students will be seated by classroom at the start of the school year so they can continue to develop the school community.
- Lunch Supervisors will be assigned specific tables to monitor.

## Lunchroom Behavior

- Show good manners
- Use appropriate language and inside voices
- Clean up after yourself. Recycle as much as you can!
- Stay in your seat, unless you ask permission
- Keep all food in cafeteria
- Wait quietly to be dismissed for recess

The Lunch Supervisor will give directions for dismissal for recess. Students must line up quietly in a single file line.





# PLAYGROUND

## RESPECT OTHERS AND YOURSELF.

- Follow instructions given by staff.
- Take turns on equipment.
- Show good sportsmanship in games.
- Settle differences peacefully. Use Kelso chart.

## BE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR OWN BEHAVIOR AND FOLLOW SCHOOL RULES.

- Food, gum or candy is not allowed on the playground.
- Leave all electronic toys and balls at home. Use school equipment.
- Follow school rules for games.
- At the end of recess, line up quickly in the designated spot to enter the building quietly in a single file line on the right.

## ACT SAFELY.

- Keep hands and feet to yourself.
- Play within boundaries.
  - Keep away from puddles, mud and any dangerous areas
  - Stay out of the woods
  - Do not climb on the fences, backstops and equipment boxes
  - Stay off snow hills
- Leave rocks, bark, sticks and other dangerous objects on the ground.
- If a ball goes out of the playground, ask an adult for help.
- Snowball throwing is not allowed.

## USE PROPER LANGUAGE.

- Speak respectfully to everyone.

## RESPECT SCHOOL PROPERTY.

- Keep the building and grounds free of litter.
- Use the school playground equipment appropriately.
- Return playground equipment to its storage location.



# PLAYGROUND

## GAME SPECIFIC RULES

### PLAY STRUCTURE

Use the equipment and the surrounding area in a safe manner.

#### SLIDES

- One student at a time on a slide
- Sit feet first
- Follow one-way direction: Go UP the steps and DOWN the slide



#### SWINGS

- One student at a time on a swing
- Sit, swinging back and forth, not sideways or twisting
- Keep a safe distance from swings in use

#### MONKEY BARS

- One student at a time going in one direction.
- Monkey bars are for hanging, not sitting on



#### BASKETBALL

- Refrain from fouling, pushing, ball hogging
- Games other than traditional basketball, such as Horse or Around the World, may be played if all players agree.

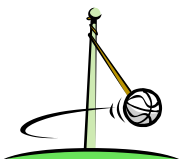


#### FOUR SQUARE

- Bounce the ball underhand with open hand
- If others are waiting to play, rotate out when ball is missed.

#### TETHERBALL

- Goal of game is to wind the rope completely around the pole
- Only hit the ball with hands
- A foul is committed if the ball is held or caught
- **Do not climb the pole**; ask an adult for assistance in connecting the ball





# PLAYGROUND

## GAME SPECIFIC RULES

### SOCCER

- Soccer is a non-contact game.
- Play only on the field, not on the black top.
- Keep the ball on the ground.
- Field players may only use their feet (no heading!); goalies may use arms and hands



### FOOTBALL

- Play only on the field, not on the black top.
- Tackling is not allowed at any time. Flag football only.

### KICKBALL

- Play only on the field, not on the black top.
- Runner must be tagged with ball; ball may not be thrown at runner.



# DISMISSAL

**ALL STUDENTS WILL BE ACCOMPANIED TO THE LOBBY BY THEIR TEACHERS.**

**GRADE 4 & 5**

Go down the side stairway with their teacher or designated adult.

**GRADE 2 & 3**

Go down the main staircase with their teacher or designated adult.

**KINDERGARTEN & GRADE 1**

Escorted to the lobby by their teacher or designated adult.

**BUS RIDERS**

Students riding the bus home will line up by bus number in the hallway outside the Music Room. Students will sit quietly against the wall.
